These simple three things help guide everyone at Saint Monica's. Everything we do, say and think should reflect these three statements. We have a School-Wide Expectation that by living these three statements we show respect to others and ourselves. This approach also reinforces the Catholic social teachings around the "dignity of the human person".

As a whole school we are currently focusing on appropriate language for the school setting. I am asking families to talk around the difference between the language used at home or in private, verses what's used at school. Parents are asked to explain what's appropriate at school. Part of this is explaining that words that may not be offensive at home or to their family may be offensive to others. Part of this may involve talking around words that may be considered "soft" swear words. This will help in building a shared community understanding that the use of these "soft" swear words is also not appropriate for school. Make it clear that swearing of any kind is not tolerated in school and will result in negative consequences.

As part of a positive approach I also ask families to talk about using kind words and polite language and how this is a sign of respect and that people enjoy being in the company of those who treat them with respect. Having a positive approach to how we react when things may not go our way helps students to learn that maintaining a positive outlook is not just good for school, but helps us in lots of other

PASSION & PATHWAYS

St Monica's have been invited to join a dynamic partnership with the business and industry sectors in Bendigo to offer your child a unique insight into the 'world of work.'

In conjunction with a government approved organisation called Passions and Pathways, Grade 6 children will visit real workplaces to understand what employment means and undertake a range of authentic work related experiences. Passions and Pathways is a unique program - conceived and nurtured in Bendigo - that has been changing the lives of Year 6 students since 2012.

Passions and Pathways is a partnership between the Goldfields Local Learning and Employment Network (GLEN), four Bendigo primary schools, state and local government, industry bodies and more than 40 local businesses and organisations.

Over the past 5 years around 280 grade six students have completed the program which introduces them to the world of work. The program is aligned with the Victorian Curriculum and includes:

- OHS orientation
- Experiences at La Trobe University and the Bendigo Schools' Trade Training Centre
- Young Industry Ambassadors from workplaces share their experiences with the students
- Workplace Tours
- Workplace Projects with applied learning over 6 weeks
- An Expo/Showcase to celebrate student learning with parents and teachers

I believe this is an amazing opportunity for our students to participate in a program that will offer them a unique opportunity and insight into the world of work. Book Title	Big Little Lies

Big Little Lies follows three women Madeleine a divorcee, Celeste a beautiful women who makes the world stop and stare. Jane a young single mum new to town. These women all live in a little beachfront town where their children are just starting in prep at the local public primary school. Amidst doting mums, successful husbands, beautiful children and stunning homes exists a community fuelled by rumours and divided into myths regarding perfection, romance marriage, parenting and friendship. The story all evolves around a Parent and friends Trivia fundraising night that ends in a tale of murder, fractured relationships between husbands and wives, parents and children, friends and neighbours.

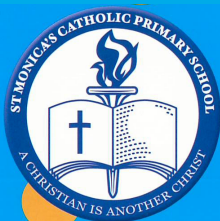

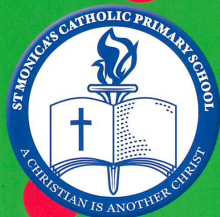

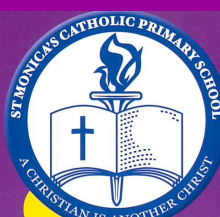
